# **TME CAMBRIDGE CAIE CANDIDATES ACADEMIC ACTION PLAN**

**UPDATED POLICY STATEMENT ON SUNDAY 5<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2020**

## **Dear Parents/Guardians, Learners, Staff and Community Members**

Hope you are keeping safe and calm amidst the Corona Virus crises. To effectively adapt to the unforeseen scenario of teaching and learning, our students and teachers have shifted from regular medium of instructions i.e. face to face teaching to online teaching through Microsoft Teams and currently are actively engaged in online classes and assessments and submitting the assigned tasks for teachers' reflective feedback. Candidates shall also be sitting for online real-time mock exams as scheduled.

According to the latest update released on 31st March, Cambridge Board has cancelled its May/June 2020 Examination Series and candidates who were registered for May/June 2020 exams will be awarded their CAIE grades on the basis of collaborative assessment framework by your registered Cambridge School/College and the Cambridge CAIE Exam Board as per their revised policy.

Having carefully considered all options and keeping in mind feedback from all stakeholders, our internal policy on the subject matter is as follows;

### **For IGCSE-II**

**Option 1:** Candidates can withdraw exam entry for the May/June 2020 Exam Series and will re-register for the Oct/Nov 2020 Exam Series.(Provided Cambridge offers all such exams in the Oct/Nov 2020 exam series).

**Option 2:** TME Candidate can also apply for the evidence-based grades for CAIE's May/June 2020 exam series. The evidence that school will submit to CAIE to award these grades will include under the collaborative assessment framework shall include;

- IGCSE-I Internal Exam Results.
- IGCSE-II Sessional & Online Mock Result
- Two marked assignments (answer sheet and results) for each subject (new).
- Teachers Evaluation (new).

### **For IGCSE-III**

TME will apply for the evidence-based grades for CAIE's May/June 2020 exam series for ALL subjects & ALL students. The evidence that school will submit to CAIE under the collaborative assessment framework for grades will include;

- IGCSE-1 Internal Exam Results.
- IGCSE-II Internal Exam Results.
- IGCSE-III Sessional & Online Mock Results.
- CAIE/EDEXCEL results of IGCSE-II (Pak. Studies, Islamiyat, Urdu and any other subject taken by the students).
- Two marked assignments (answer sheet and results) for each subject (new).
- Online Assessment (answer sheet and results) for each subject (new)
- Teachers Evaluation (new).

You all are expected to get good grades based on above evidences. If not, then you may re-visit that particular subject in Oct/Nov 2020 Exam series, if need be. Another benefit of evidence-based grades would be timely University placements, SAT and portfolio building cycle and timely start of progression into AS levels when schools open for face-to-face teaching & learning after the lockdown. These times are unprecedented and uncertain, so we must benefit from timely progression and evidence-based assessment opportunity.

### **For AS Level**

**Option 1:** TME candidates will appear in composite / linear exams in May/June 2021. Composite / Linear Exams mean that the Students shall take/attempt all components of paper of the Cambridge International A Level course AS/A level together in the same examination series i.e. at the end of the second year of study; the Exams for which will be held in May/June 2021.

**Option 2:** TME candidates can also apply for the evidence-based grades with CAIE under the collaborative assessment grading framework for the May/June 2020 exam series. The evidence that school/college will submit to CAIE under the collaborative assessment framework for award of these grades, will include;

- IGCSE/O Level/IB-MYP/High School/Matriculation SSC Results.
- AS Sessionals, Mid-Term & Online Mock Results.
- Two marked assignments (answer sheet and results) for each subject (new).
- Online Assessment (answer sheet and results) for each subject (new)
- Teachers Evaluation (new).

### **For A (A2) Level**

**Option 1:** TME CAIE candidates can apply for the evidence-based collaborative assessment framework for grades with CAIE for the May/June 2020 exam series. The evidence that school/college will submit to CAIE for award of these grades will include;

- AS Level Results.
- A2 Sessional, Mid-Term & Online Mock Results.
- Two marked assignments (answer sheet and results) for each subject (new).
- Online Assessment (answer sheet and results) for each subject (new)
- Teachers Evaluation (new).

**Option 2:** TME CAIE candidates who may wish to opt to withdraw from May/Jun 2020 Exam Series, will get a credit note and school shall re-register our CAIE candidates for Oct/Nov 2020 Exam Series (provided Cambridge offer all such exams in the Oct/Nov 2020 exam series and extend the validity of the AS level CAIE award). The difference in the fee, if any, will have to be paid by the candidate. Results of Oct /Nov 2020 will be released in January 2021 and it may have an impact on their Univeristy applications cycle and Conditional offers and may result in a gap year.
