



About the Qualificaftions;

The average age level for this qualification is 11-14 years. The curriculum framework offered by The Millennium Middle Years Programme is designed for the educational success of learners in that age group.

Based on curriculum of English, Science, Mathematics, History, Geography, Social Studies, Islamiyat and Urdu, this programme aims to stimulate the minds of our learners to prepare for the challenging study in the years to come. The knowledge and skills developed in TMMYP can ensure a smooth transition from secondary to higher national/international qualifications.

About the Curriculum:

Exposure and engagement during ages 11 - 14 years, gives learners an indispensable intellectual toolkit. TME Subject-based syllabus allows for much more than the transmission of knowledge necessary for further study or work. They promote meaningful engagement in realworld problems and help develop high-level skills that learners can apply in unfamiliar situations. Cambridge Checkpoint

The Millennium Education introduced Grade VIII as an extension of Cambridge Checkpoint Grades VI and VII to



offer the last year of this Middle Years' Programme for learners of age 11-14 years. Grade VII checkpoint learners are promoted to Grade VIII checkpoint and avail the full academic year for a better preparation required to enter Cambridge IGCSE level.

Cambridge Checkpoint tests are designed for learners who are beginning courses leading to Cambridge IGCSE or Cambridge O Level Examinations in English, Mathematics, and Science. Grade VIII Millennials appear in the Secondary Checkpoint Test May Series and attempt CAIE papers that are externally marked using Cambridge Checkpoint scores. At the end of the Checkpoint Exam, each learner receives a statement of achievement and a diagnostic feedback report. These exams are optional, and learners register for the mentioned subjects with the consent of their parents. Moreover, this does not affect those learners who do not qualify for this exam. They take their internal exams for Grade VIII at campus level.

International General Certificate for Secondary Education (IGCSE) is the world's most popular international qualification for 14-16 year olds, attracting over 900,000 subject entries every year from 140 countries.

How is Cambridge IGCSE taught?

Internal assessments take place throughout the course of three years. The learners are given options that include written, oral, coursework and practical assessments. The learner's academic progress is assessed through sessional, terminals, mock exams, oral tests, practical exercises, home assignments, projects and written examinations. The learners' progress is carefully tracked by the faculty and the result folder is reviewed by parents. The report cards for the sessional and term exams are sent home after exams. The marks and subjects comments are



uploaded on LMS (Learning Management System). Parent Teacher Meeting is held twice in each term and four times in an academic year. After analyzing the results of 1st mock exam and two-year performance, school principal and subject teachers decide to get the child registered for core or extended curriculum in CAIE external examination.

IBCC Equivalence:

The government of Pakistan recognizes Cambridge qualifications and provides equivalence to local system of education in order to ensure smooth progression for learners who choose to pursue their education in Pakistan.

The government body responsible for issuing equivalence conversion is the Inter Board Committee of Chairman (IBCC, www.ibcc.edu.pk) Cambridge O Level and Cambridge IGCSE are equated to the local Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and Cambridge International A Levels to the Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSSC).

National Secondary School Certificate (SSC) is the recognized qualification in Pakistan based on the textbooks and curricula prepared by Education Department Government of the Punjab and approved by the Federal Government for implementation at national level. The Federal Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education (FBISE) Islamabad established under FBISE ACT 1975 is an autonomous body of the Ministry of Education, Trainings and Standards in Higher Education.

It is empowered with administrative and financial authority to organize, regulate, develop and control Intermediate and Secondary Education in general and conduct examinations in the institutions affiliated with it. The resulting qualification provides a foundation for higher level courses, such as FSC, ICS, I.COM or 'A' and 'AS' levels.

About the Curriculum

Federal board of Intermediate and Secondary Education Islamabad and Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education Rawalpindi has offered a flexible course of study that gives candidates option to choose subjects of their choice whilst providing them with a broad knowledge based on lifelong skills.

About TME Examination, Assessment & Progression System

Matric SSC is usually taught as a three-year course starting from Grade 8 at The Millennium Education Schools and Colleges for learners aged 13 to 16 years. Monthly assessment is a regular part of high school. Send-ups exams are taken every year in the month of November/December. Final examinations are taken in the month of March/April each year by FBISE and BISE on their said patterns. After completion of SSC, a learner qualifies for Higher Secondary School Certification.

The Millennium Education Matric Acceptance & Recognition

Matric qualification is acceptable and acts as a gateway



for acquiring national or international education in colleges and universities in the country or abroad.

How is SSC taught at The Millennium Education Colleges?

The Millennium Education Colleges offer only science combination (Computer Science group and Biology group) at SSC level. The prescribed course of Matric is taught through textbooks approved by Punjab textbook Board Lahore and National Book Foundation Islamabad. In order to prepare the learners for the tough national competition at SSC level, 60% of Grade 9th syllabus is covered in Grade 8. The rest of the syllabus for Grade 9 is covered in the first term of Grade 9; second term of Grade 9 is reserved for complete revision, testing and improvement by repeated evaluation system. This is done to provide marks-oriented practice to the learners for SSC Part 1.

The SSC Part 2 classes commence in May and 35% of syllabus is covered before the summer break. The remaining of the syllabus is covered by October, and the remaining months prior to the Part 2 board examinations are dedicated to revision, testing and improvement by repeated evaluation system. This practice has ensured a remarkable result aggregate of 90% A's and A* in the SSC examinations for Millennials and gives them a competitive edge.


About Cambridge AS & A -Level

GCE Advanced (A) Level is one of the most recognized qualifications around the world. For over 50 years, Cambridge International A Level Pakistan has been accepted as proof of academic ability for entry to universities and institutes of higher education while Advanced Subsidiary (AS) Level represents the first half of a full A Levels course and gives learners the opportunity to study a broader range of subjects without committing to a full A level.

Generally, learners progress to AS and A Levels in the academic year following their IGCSE, IB-MYP and Matric result. The Cambridge Assessment International Education (CAIE) board is the main body to offer International AS and A Levels.

About Cambridge Assessment International Examinations CAIE

Cambridge AS Level examinations are usually taken at the age of 17 years and Cambridge A Level examinations at age of 18 years. Cambridge A-Level courses take two years to complete with exams taken at the end. Cambridge AS Level examinations are taken after a year either as part of the A Level course, or as a qualification. Alternatively, the A Level qualification will be taken at the end of a two-year course. Examinations are held in May/June and October/November each year with results issued in August and February respectively. It is mandatory for all learners to be registered in advance with TME Colleges before taking the A Level examination.



Where are AS & A Levels accepted and recognized?

Cambridge International A Level is a "gold standard" qualification, high A and AS Level grades are key to admission for all the world's top universities, and almost all the top universities in Pakistan. Good grades at A Level can result in up to one full year of advanced standing or credit at Universities in USA, Canada or Pakistan. AS Level carries half the weight-age of an A Level and is typically awarded half the credit value. This is a general guide. To find out the exact number of A and AS Levels and grades required for further study, it is advisable to contact the dedicated TME 'AS' & 'A' level admission advisors/counsellor.

The Millennium College Years Programme

(High Secondary **School Certificate HSSC)**

The HSSC (Higher Secondary School Certificate) is an educational qualification offered by the FBISE in Pakistan. It is a two-year programme of study that is equivalent to the 12th grade or second year of college education in other countries. To obtain the HSSC qualification from the FBISE, a learner must complete a two-year programme. The HSSC examination is held in two parts, Part I and Part II. Part I is usually taken in the first year of the programme, while Part II is taken in the second year.

The HSSC qualification from the FBISE is widely recognized in Pakistan and is a pre-requisite for admission to most undergraduate programmes in colleges and universities. It is also recognized by many international educational institutions and can be used to apply for admission to universities and colleges abroad.







different TME campuses at 14 major cities i.e. Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Nowshera, Mardan, Attock Kamra, Sargodha, Mirpur, Sialkot, Jhelum, Karachi, Lahore, Abbottabad & Peshawar. During the German Language Programme, learners study the first level of the language framework called FIT-1. Level 1 of FIT-1 is taught over a period of two years, and Learners take their first exam of FIT-1 at the end of the second year. The exams are conducted by the Goethe Institute examiners.

German Language Programme for Upper Middle Years and College Years: IGCSE and A Levels.

German language is offered as an optional subject to the IGCSE, AS and A2 learners. The German teachers take extra

lessons for the IGCSE learners apart from their scheduled lessons and prepare them for the International German Language Exam in one Year.

IGCSE learners can be prepared to take the International Goethe German Language Exam after one academic year.

AS and A level learners are taught A-1 within a year, enabling them to take their A-1 and B-1 level examinations consecutively. German language is taught using a range of inventive and engaging approaches to enhance the enjoyment and activity-based nature of learning. Upon completion of A Level with a B-2 certification in the German language, learners are eligible to apply for scholarships in Germany.

Over 3000 learners are currently learning German, with over 500 achieving a perfect score of 100% in the FIT-1, FIT-2, and B1 examinations administered by Goethe Institute examiners.

The "Schools: Partners for the Future" initiative is expanding its efforts to foster connections and introduce learners from various countries and communities to the German education system. The initiative offers integrated German lessons in schools, providing a platform for learners to form strong bonds and gain familiarity with the German education system.




Scope - School Coaching Programme

STUDENT REGISTRATION FORM 'SRF-001'

All prospective candidates/ learners seeking admission are required to fill 'Student Registration Form SRF-001' to register themselves, however, registration does not guarantee admission which is subject to the candidate's clearing 'Admission Assessment Test AAT-001' and/or a subsequent interview as per the TME admission policy and rules. ADMISSION ASSESSMENT TEST 'AAT-001'

All prospective learners seeking admission must qualify the TME 'Admission Assessment Test AAT-001' and/or an interview. Moreover, the prospective learners must obtain a school leaving certificate or the progress and promotion report from the previous school/college to be eligible for admission in the next grade. The assessments are general in nature and are aimed to better evaluate the learners` suitability for the recommended grade and are only aimed to understand learner academic needs and areas of strength and study support. The assessment shall be based on the general understanding and knowledge of the subject level for the grade he/she is seeking admission for. As a result of admission assessment/test and/or interview, where the learner is not found suitable for the admission into the grade for which admission is being sought, and then the possibility of accepting him/her in any other grade will not be considered unless the learner is re-registered and re-assessed for the particular grade. Moreover, TME reserves the right to accept or refuse registration or admission without assigning any reason. For inter board transfers, learners are expected to obtain a 'No Objection Certificate' from the previous board within Pakistan.

Payment of Fees

On acceptance, the learner is issued a 'Fee Bill'. Tuition and fee is payable in PKR for the full academic year or 12 calendar months (including June to August period). The Tuition & fee is payable in advance on a bi-monthly basis or for external examination classes on four-monthly basis, through the specified branches.

Issuance of Student Admission Slip 'SAS-001'

All parent/guardian responsible for guaranteeing payment of School Tuition & Fee will read and sign an undertaking for compliance with the School's Rules and Policies as outlined in

the 'Admission Form Pack AFP-001'. The School reserves the right to revise and make alterations to its rules and policies at any point in time without any prior notice. The Millennium Education shall provide a 'Student Admission slip SAS-001' or confirm admission to any learner if the parent/guardian has submitted (4 recent passport size colored photographs of the learner, learners` Form 'B' Copy and/or Copy of Original Birth Certificate, Copy of both Parents/Guardians CNIC (Pakistani Nationals Only), Copy of last 2 pages of passport of the parents/guardians (Foreign Nationals Only), Previous Original School Leaving Certificate & Copies of your child last School Report and Certificates) and duly signed the documents included in the 'Admission Form Pack AFP-001' at the time of admission.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

THE MILLENNIUM EARLY YEARS PROGRAMME - TMEY

Reception, Play Group, Junior Year & Advanced Year (2 years to 5 years plus)

Children are admitted in the Early Years on the first come first serve basis as seats are limited; however, admission in Early Years is open throughout the year to fill in any vacancy.

A child can be admitted from the age of 2 years plus to 5 years plus. Admission will be granted, subject to clearing informal interview with the section head / coordinator / school head.

For Early Years an informal assessment is conducted combined with an interview with the Parents/Guardian. Generally, the reading ability of the child, vocabulary and recognition of words, concepts of colours and numbers is assessed. The confidence and development of motor skills and appearance of the child is also taken into consideration how the child sits, walks and talks.

At the time of admission, an appointment is given for the parents to meet with the Head of the Early Years section. The child is assessed in an informal environment separately.

Both the parents must be present at the time of interview, failing which the admission cannot be processed.

The 'Admission Assessment Test AAT-001' is not set from any specific textbooks or syllabi but is of a general multiple-choice questionnaire designed to test the aptitude of the child or his /her academic ability.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

THE MILLENNIUM MIDDLE YEARS PROGRAMME - TMMY (Grade 6 to 8 / Cambridge Checkpoint)

All new learners admitted in our system in class 9th, 10th &11th have to follow the following scheme of studies.

- The Millennium Education offers 3 years 'O' level & IGCSE programme, depending upon the learner's academic background and subject to acceptance on the desired programme by the Admissions and Academic Advisor or School Head.
- TME offer O levels / IGCSE through the Cambridge and Edexcel Board UK. (Please re-confirm with the local campus for more details).
- After completing 'O' level / IGCSE Scheme of studies, learners are eligible for entry into all colleges / A level.
- Keeping in view the basic requirement of sound academic base and ability to understand a wide range of subjects, spanning the 'O' Level & IGCSE course to a duration of 3 years is unavoidable. Any shortcuts to this schedule will invariably carry the risk of your child ending up in lower grades in the first stage.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme IB-MYP

Learners will be administered test in English, Mathematics, Sciences and/or Urdu in order to evaluate their academic abilities besides taking into account their previous academic record before being granted admission into the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme at The Millennium Education.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION THE MILLENNIUM UPPER MIDDLE YEARS - TMUMY (Grade 9 to 10)

Matriculation - Secondary School Certificate SSC

■ The learner will be tested in 5 subjects" i.e., English,

Admission & Eligibility Policy

Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Computers. Admission is subject to securing 70% pass percentage in all the subjects.

- For class IX and X Registration Return Copy should be provided from the previous school.
- Learners coming from schools affiliated with Examination Board other than Punjab or Federal have to provide NOC from the respective board.
- Original School Leaving Certificate SLC from a registered and recognized institute should be provided failing which the school does not take responsibility for registration of the learner with the local examination board.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

THE MILLENNIUM COLLEGE YEARS - TMCY

AS & A Levels

Cambridge AS Level examinations are usually taken at the age 17 years and Cambridge A Level examinations at age 18 years.

- A minimum of 5 passes is required in 'O' levels or 'IGCSE' level examinations to be eligible for admissions into the AS level programme at TME.
- For learners from Matric stream, a minimum of overall 'A' grade or 70% marks are required to be eligible for admission into the AS Level programme at TME.
- learners have already taken IGCSEs or 'O' Levels from The Millennium Education then they will find many of the academic skills they have already learnt relevant and beneficial to AS level study at TME.

SCHOLARSHIP POLICY FOR AS AND A LEVELS ONLY (MONTHLY TUITION FEE ONLY)

Any student qualifying for the Merit-Based Scholarship will be awarded a scholarship as per the policy.

Higher Secondary School Certificate HSSC

Eligibility Criteria

F.Sc. (Pre-Medical)

Candidates must have completed their Matriculation with a minimum of 70% marks and have studied the following subjects at the Matriculation level: Physics, Chemistry, and Biology. In case of O-Level, candidates must have completed their O-level or equivalent examination with at least six subjects, including Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, and English. Candidates must have obtained at least B/C grades in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, and Biology are eligible to take admission.

F.Sc. (Pre-Engineering)

Candidates must have completed their Matriculation with a minimum of 70% marks and have must have studied the following subjects at the Matriculation level: Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics. In case of O-Level, candidates must have completed their O-Level or equivalent examination with at least eight subjects, including Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, and English. Candidates must have obtained at least B/C grades in Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry are eligible to take admission.

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Candidates must have completed their Matriculation/O-Level or equivalent examination with at least 60% marks.

SCHOLARSHIP POLICY FOR HSSC PROGRAMMES ONLY (MONTHLY TUITION FEE ONLY)

Any student qualifying for the Merit-Based Scholarship will be awarded a scholarship as per the policy.

GENERAL ADMISSION RULES:

- Application for admission is taken on the prescribed school form Admission Form Pack AFP-001.
- 2. The grade or level for which the student is to be assessed is determined according to his/her age at the time of the 'Admission Assessment Test AAT-001' and not according to the age put down at registration.
- A candidate can be rejected without being given a test if undue pressure is applied or if unfair means are restored to for the acquisition of admission.
- 4. In all cases merit is the criterion for admission.
- 5. The Admission Assessment Tests are not set from any specific textbooks or syllabus but are of a general design to assess the aptitude of the child.
- 6. The assessments are not shown to anyone; only results are communicated with the parents / guardian through 'Admission Assessment Card AAC-001'.
- 7. A candidate caught cheating during the test will be rejected.
- 8. A candidate rejected once will be given another chance in the same year. However, such a learner may apply again the following year. If rejected in the second attempt, he/she cannot apply to TME the third time.
- 9. The decision of the school/college cannot be challenged in any way and will be absolutely final.
- 10. Scholarships for AS & A Levels are offered as per AS & A Level Scholarship Policy.

NOTE: The Millennium Education does not offer scholarships for 'O" Levels or IGCSE course of studies or any other tier of its education system other than AS & A Levels/HSSC; subject to availability.

Assessment & Examination Policy

Develops thinking and analytical skills which will go a long way in helping advanced studies

Continuous Assessment at The Millennium Education is the educational policy in which learners are examined continuously over most of the duration of their education, the results of which are taken into account after leaving school. The Millennium Education is using internationally benchmarked tests, giving parents extra trust in the feedback they receive. In Grade I to III, pupils are continuously monitored to assess performance and behaviour. These assessments are detailed in "Progress Reports cards", which are sent to parents twice a year. Monthly progress reports are sent home to keep the parents fully informed about their child's development. For Grade I – III, on the basis of class assignments, monthly progress reports are sent to the parents. These reports are retained in the school. In classes IV to X, assessment is via class tests, sessionals, a terminal and final examination.

Final Examination shows the entire year's work and performance of the child in the class room. Promotions and selections are at the discretion of the School Head whose decision is considered as final. A learner who has failed in a class twice may be withdrawn from the school. The School Head can recommend withdrawal if a learner's performance is detected to be weak. Report cards sent to the Parents/ Guardians are not to be retained by them according to assessment & examination Policy of Millennium Education System – also they are returned duly signed to evince that the report cards have been seen.

At TME there is a sharp awareness of the need to keep the parents fully informed of the progress of their children and of the various developments, which take place. It is understood that it is through parents / teacher contact that firm relationships and understandings are established. As such, regular parent/teacher meetings are held in the school whereby parents are given an opportunity to come and meet the teachers to discuss progress and other matters pertaining to the welfare of the students. School circulars are issued accordingly.

TME Assessment & Examination Policy provides students with a constant stream of opportunities to prove their mastery of material and sends the message that everyone can succeed if given enough time and practice. This reduces the anxiety and finality around testing and heightens the emphasis on the learning itself. Advanced learners progress through material at their own pace and remain engaged by pursuing more challenging work as they pass out of the basics. In this sense, the standards for such learners stretch to help each of them maximize potential. Because success is defined on an absolute



and individualized basis, learners cannot be satisfied with their achievements relative to others; they are encouraged to seek their own course and take responsibility for their learning.

At TME, there is increased self-awareness for learners who, through assessment, come to understand their proficiencies and knowledge gaps. Time and again, we encounter evidence that self-awareness understanding of how one feels, thinks, and learns is one of the most significant factors in professional and personal success. The more continuously we assess our learners, the more knowledge they gain about themselves what it takes for them to master something, how they can approach problems differently, what their blind spots are, and how to eliminate them. The Millennium Education assessments provide early indicators of the likely performance of learners, something that is of great help to them.

School Uniform Policy

Gives learners a sense of belonging & creates an identity for The Millennium Education Schools in the community

The Millennium Education School Uniform policy was developed by the School Board in accordance with policy and guidelines on dress standards for learners. The wearing of school uniform is supported strongly by the TME community and is a symbol of pride in the school. There is an expectation that learners will comply with the dress requirements and that valuable school time will not need to be diverted to following up on breaches of school uniform policy.

Our careful selection of TME school uniform contributes to the health and safety of our students when engaged in school activities. RMS School Uniform reflects school community standards and expectations.

Response to learners who do not wear uniform is appropriate. They are clarified, agreed upon by the school community and documented. Response is fair and consistent. We don't prevent learners from continued participation in essential curriculum activities except where exclusion is necessary for reasons of safety. In this situation, alternative educational activities are provided. It is the responsibility of the School Head to ensure that the school uniform policy is followed collaboratively with the school community.

Uniform Guidelines Policy for Girls

- The Millennium Schools blazers should be worn at all times during winter.
- The Millennium Schools sash, badge, and computerized ID card must be worn at all times.
- Girls Kameez / Shirts should be the regulation design and should be worn at the knee level.
- No fancy kameez and shalwar are allowed other than regulation design.
- T-Shirts with visible slogans should not be worn under shirts
- Shoes should be polished and flat in style (no high heels). They should have no visible markings.
- Hair should be well kept in a moderate style without streaks or other colors. Styles are not allowed. Shoulder length hair should be tied back off the face or held in a black band.
- No jewelry, ornaments, and accessories should be worn at any time.

■ No make-up or nail polish should be worn.

Uniform Guidelines Policy for Boys

- The Millennium Schools blazers/jackets/cardigans should be worn at all times during winter.
- The Millennium Schools belt, badge, and computerized ID card must be worn at all times.
- Trousers should be standard school trousers in cut and material.
- No fancy shirt and trouser are allowed other than regulation design.
- Shirts should be worn tucked in.
- Ties should be worn down to the waist.
- Plain school socks should be worn. Shoes should be polished and flat in style. They should have no visible markings.
- Hair should be neat, clean and of acceptable length. Hair may not cut in any fancy style or be coloured, streaked or be tied.

Tuition & Fee Policy

Provision is made for continuous growth in social and emotional development through balanced programmes

All learners, parents and guardians must observe the following rules and regulation as outlined in this Policy Note regarding Tuition and Fees.


Tuition and Fee, payable in Pak Rupees, for the Academic year is as follows.

- A one-time Registration and Admission Fee (non-refundable) will be paid by all new students in full at the time of admission. Security fee is payable at the time of admission and is refundable at the time of withdrawal. Annual Resource Charge for the academic year will be paid in full prior to admission irrespective of joining date. Student ID Card, Learning Management System, Montessori School Bag, School Badge and Prospectus shall be payable at the time of admission.
- The Annual Resource Charge, Learning Management System (LMS) Charges and School Computerized student ID Card shall be charged annually.
- The Tuition & Fee will be payable on bi-monthly basis in advance for all tiers except examination classes.
- The Tuition & Fee for examination year classes of '0' Level, IGCSE, AS & A Levels, and all external Examination programmers shall be paid on Four monthly basis as per the following schedule.

First Payment: September - December

Second Payment : January - April
Third Payment: May - August

- For all Admission the monthly Tuition Fee cut-off date is 20th of every calendar month. The monthly tuition fee for the current period shall be charged to all new admission fee bills issued before or on 20th of every calendar month.
- The Millennium Education fee for the full year or 12 calendar months (which includes May to August Period) is to be paid in full for all existing and graduating learners. (Monthly Lab, ICT, Computer Charges, Robotics and Language Charges are also applicable for the full year or 12 calendar months including May to August Period).
- Monthly Tuition Fee, Admission fee, Security, Annual Resource Charge, Registration fee, ID Card Charge, Prospectus, year Book, School Bag, school badge or ICT/Lab charge and all other charges as per the tuition & fee policy are all subject to review from time to time due to inflationary pressure are subject to increase without prior notice at any time.



- Tuition & Fee bills are normally issued with a "DUE DATE" of 10 days. After the expiry of "DUE DATE" the fee Bill can be deposited with the late payment fine which is charged on a daily basis, till the expiry of "VALIDITY DATE" which is normally 5 days from the expiry of the "DUE DATE". After the expiry of the validity date the fee bill shall not be accepted at the local branch of the bank. The New fee bill will only be issued with an additional fine of Rs. 500/- per fee bill plus the late payment charge incurred till that day.
- Learners whose fees remain payable after the expiry of "DUE/VALIDITY DATE" are issued a periodic reminder and ultimately the "Final Reminder", thereafter which the learner's name will be struck off the school roll and outstanding name adjusted against security deposit and a re-admission charge shall be levied.
- Parents / Guardians defaulting on fee payment, run the risk of making their children /wards liable being struck off the school roll. The security deposit of learner is adjusted against the unpaid Tuition & Fee balance. In such cases, readmission is subject to vacancy and repayment of both the admission fee and security deposit at the prevailing rates
- The security Deposit is refunded in full at the time of the withdrawal of the learner or Request for school Leaving Certificate RSLC-001 after completion of studies or otherwise provided that the learner has paid all his/her dues and the school has no justifiable claim outstanding.

Tuition & Fee Policy

■ Fee Bills are issued latest by 25th of the month and sent home through learner It is the responsibility of the parents to inquire from the school's office if they have not received the fee bill by the 5th of the billing months. All due are paid directly to the The Millennium Education Schools specified branch of a local bank. The payment due date and the fee bill validity date is marked on the fee bill, and late-fee is collected by the bank at the time of payment.

NOTE: The late payment charges will not be waived nor reduced in any circumstances

- Registration fee, admission fee, annual Resource Charges are non-refundable under any circumstance. For learners leaving mid-term, balance payment of tuition fee is not refundable. No refunds for any payments will be made if learner is suspended on disciplinary grounds or the learner is found in breach of the student code of conduct, and parent or guardian will be liable for property as per the student disciplinary procedure and /or as determined by the school management.
- For returning learners, all previous dues including any fine must have been cleared. Non-payment or underpayment of dues may result in suspension of enrolment, refusal to CIE/Edexcel international exam registration, refusal to reregister and/or withholding of learner records.
- All dues must be cleared before the Mid Term / Annual Examination to appear in assessment / paper. The Millennium Education reserves the right to hold learner's progress reports, transcripts, examination entries, school leaving and other certificates if the dues have not been cleared.
- All parents and guardians responsible for guaranteeing payment of school dues will read and sign an undertaking for compliance with the TME policies as outlined in the TME Prospectus and Admission Form Pack. The school reserves the right to revise and make alterations to its policies, and fees at any point in time WITHOUT further notice.
- All fees must be paid in full as cleared funds by the Due date as specified on the fee bill. Thereafter, late payment charges shall be lived by the designated bank as per the Tuition & fee policy.
- In an event of student inter branch or city transfer, the security fee shall NOT be transferred to the region responsible, however there is no admission, registration and/or security charge in an event of inter branch or intercity school transfer within The Millennium Education Nationwide.
- There will be no concession or fee waiver for the period

- that a child may have stayed away from the school, due to illness, social commitments, visit abroad or for any reason.
- If the school is closed due to emergency war, epidemic, floods, and earthquake or for any other reason on National, Provisional, District or AJK State Government order for any length of time, parent / guardians shall pay the fees with regularity by the 10th. The salaries to the teaching staff, Faculty, administrative and support staff etc. Have to be paid during the closed period.
- There is late payment charge to be levied on fee bill by the bank if the fee is late by the Due date as specified on the fee bill.

Late payment charges

Rs.100/- per day after expiration of due date till the validity date.

Rs. 500/- for issuance of new fee bill after the expiration of the validity date plus the late payment charge.

The school includes in its annual report to parents, information concerning the arrangements made for the admission of Special pupils; the steps taken to prevent disabled pupils from being treated less favourably than other pupils; the facilities provided to assist access to the school by disabled pupils. Progress in this area is documented in the School's Action Plan. The school recognises its need to celebrate the diversity that exists within its community and ensures that all have the opportunity to respond to the expectations and challenges of the curriculum. It is our school policy to incorporate a balanced view of the world through a multi-cultural approach, to recognise that our pupils are world citizens who will meet a wide variety of cultures throughout their lives, to evaluate our practice to ensure that it is not at the expense of indigenous cultures and to allow children equal access to opportunities according to equal opportunity policy which will equip them for adult life and to achieve challenging expectations

TME Learner Code of Conduct Policy

The utmost priority of our institution is the safety and wellbeing of our learners. The Millennium Education has a clear and formal Learner Code of Conduct policy. Being an international institution, we hope to foster an environment where all learners feel supported, listened to, and safe.

Aim of the Policy

This policy agreement aims to clarify TME position on learners' conduct and explain the processes and procedures associated with managing and sanctioning learners' conduct in ways which uphold the professional integrity of those working in TME schools and TME (the company) in its endeavours to provide international standards of education. In the event of a serious breach, criminal misconduct, or where it is believed that the health, safety or welfare of others may be jeopardized by the continuing presence of a learner they will be suspended or withdrawn from the campus admissions register immediately.

TME Expectation from Learners

In relation to the core activity of teaching and learning, Learners are expected to:

- Adopt a diligent and co-operative approach to all aspects of academic life
- Accept responsibility in creating a supportive Millennial educational community

TME Learner Code of Conduct

Throughout their period of study with The Millennium Education, Learners are expected to abide by the Learner Code of Conduct which is based upon respect for individuals, teachers, management, race, culture, religion, background, property and the environment. The following actions, whether occurring in campus premises or elsewhere, are examples of conduct which is not acceptable to The Millennium Education and may lead to instigation of formal learner disciplinary procedures:

- TME Learners Conduct which constitutes a criminal offence e.g. assault, theft, fraud, deceit, deception or dishonesty.
- Plagiarism, Violent, indecent, disorderly, threatening, abusing, intimidating or offensive behaviour or language towards any learner, teacher or member of administration and management

- Social, racial or any other form of harassment is dealt with strictly. Exemplify the high standards of personal and prosocial behaviour in respect of other learners. Develop and maintain positive relationships in Campus. Learner must work as part of a team to ensure happy and stimulating environment.
- Misuse, misappropriation, theft or damage of The Millennium Education campus property.
- TME Learner action, likely to cause injury or to impair health and safety procedures.
- TME Learner action, likely to cause injury or to impair electrical, gas and fire safety procedures.
- TME Learner failure to respect rights of others to freedom of belief and freedom of speech or expression.
- TME Learner behavior which brings the Institution into disrepute. E.g. such conduct as abusive, anti-social or discourteous behaviour, political or social activism in campus premises or outside, inconsiderate noise or parking, disregard of the campus parking code, causing litter and especially criminal damage to private property, showing disrespect to campus signs or vehicles.
- TME Learner disruption of, or improper interference with, the academic, administrative, sporting, social or other activities of the campus.
- Learner must act as per TME ethos and act in ways that promote positive behaviour in their classrooms and around campus premises.
- Obstruction of, or improper interference within the campus functionality, duties or activities of any TME Learner, member of staff, or visitor of the Institution.
- Misuse or unauthorized use of The Millennium Education Campus premises.
- Learner found violating The Millennium Education Campus study regime / time table.
- Learner found not wearing The Millennium Education authorized uniform. Learner must always show respect to the teachers, faculty members, members of The Millennium Education school administration and management
- Learner must not interfere in the functioning of The Millennium Education morning assembly presentations and national anthem.

TME Learner Code of Conduct Policy

- Learner must not cheat in examinations, assignments, assessments or in course work. Any form of plagiarism shall be dealt with firmly.
- Learner must respect the property of other people and that of The Millennium Education campus and its premises.
- Learner must not bring illegal substances onto The Millennium Education premises including drugs or alcohol.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited within The Millennium Education campus buildings, premises and parking areas and is dealt with firmly. A breach to the smoking policy may lead to withdrawal from the admissions register without further notice
- Learner must not bring The Millennium Education campus reputation into disrepute by posting or publishing any defamatory or derogatory content on social or digital media either in or off campus premises. Learner must abide by reasonable instructions issued by a member of The Millennium Education campus management or administration
- Mobile phones are not allowed and are strictly forbidden within The Millennium Education campus premises and buildings. In case of violation of school rules Mobile phones will be taken into custody by the campus administration / principal and a penalty will be imposed.
- Female Learner must not wear heels, jewellery, bangles, nail polish, earrings, fancy accessories and other ornaments within The Millennium Education campus premises. Male Learner must not wear cap, hat, unauthorized belt, bandana, boots and other fancy accessories within The Millennium Education campus premises.
- Individuals (Learner) bringing vehicles, cars, motorcycles onto campus premises must observe parking and speed restrictions and drive with care and consideration for others.
- Learner must abide by the IT & digital Code of Practice as well as campus Library Code of Practice.
- Learner must be punctual, latecomers will be fined and any leave of absence (except in case of sickness) must be given in advance in writing to the campus principal or otherwise the Learner shall be subject to 'Learner disciplinary procedure'.



- No Learner will leave campus premises during school hours without the permission of the Branch Head/Principal. TME learner must possess civility and good manners, honesty and truthfulness, and personal discipline as important TME learner attributes.
- No expensive jewellery, watches, electronic devices including laptops or iPods, pencil cases, stationery items, lunch boxes are allowed to be brought to campus. Campus management & administration will not be responsible for the loss of these articles.
- Large amount of money (beyond reasonable requirement) should not be brought to the campus. The campus will not be responsible for any loss of clothes, books, money or any other personal property or items.
- Exchange of video DVD, CD, video games, audiocassettes, magazines books or any such gift item is strictly prohibited. No parcels, lunch boxes, books, stationery etc will be entertained by the campus office during the regular school hours. All learners must bring along their own personal items once they enter campus premises in the morning.
- All notebooks used by the learner must be with school monogram, standard authorized notebooks. They are to be kept neat and labelled correctly.
- Learner must compulsorily take part in all co-curricular and

extra-curricular activities organized by the campus. These are especially designed for the overall educational needs and personality development of each child.

TME Learner Code of

Conduct Policy

- Each learner is entitled to a copy of the campus Rules and Learner Code of Conduct giving information about the ethos, values and rules of the campus. Each learner is expected to read and be compliant with, the campus Rules and learner Code of Conduct. Furthermore, parents must accept that the campus reserves the right to monitor email communications and internet use for the purpose of ensuring compliance with the campus Rules and Learner Code of Conduct.
- TME learner must abstain from reckless and malicious allegations against other TME learners, teachers or campus administrative staff.
- In an attempt of disciplinary action, the Head of the institute has the final authority to expel, dismiss, suspend or reprimand the learner.
- No learner or employee (current or former) is allowed to share any defamatory, offensive or derogatory content against the employer, campus, institution management or its stakeholders on social and digital media platforms, microblogging, social networking, social bookmarking, and social curation, and wikis, Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, Reddit, Pinterest, Instagram and any other social media platform.

Disciplinary Action Against Violation of Learner Code of Conduct

Behavior that contradicts The Millennium Education 'Learner Code of Conduct' will be dealt through the 'Learner Disciplinary Procedure'. Any misconduct will be regarded as a breach of the 'Learner Code of Conduct' and will be subject to firm action by the campus administration/ principal, which may lead to fine/ withdrawal/ expulsion/ suspension / fine depending upon the breach of conduct.

TME Harassment & Bullying Policy

The Millennium Education is committed to provide a safe environment for all its learners and employees, free from discrimination of any kind and any form of harassment. As per our learner and staff well-being and code of conduct policy we have a formal and fair Harassment and Bullying policy. TME has a zero-tolerance policy for any form of harassment in the institute, treats all incidents seriously and promptly investigates all allegations of harassment. Any learner/employee found to have harassed another will face disciplinary action. All complaints of harassment should be reported to and will be taken seriously and treated with respect and in confidence. No one will be victimised for making such a complaint.

Aim of the Policy

The aim of this policy is to ensure that all TME learners and employees are able to learn in a supportive (conducive) environment that is physically and psychologically safe (i.e. all TME learners and employees) can learn and work without fear of being bullied). It is also the aim of this policy to define, in clear terms, the expectations that teachers and other employees have of being valued and supported in their work, such that they too have a physically and psychologically safe environment for working.

This policy outlines what all Millennium schools and colleges are expected to do to prevent/ deal with all forms of harassment and bullying.

In all of our schools and colleges, we aim to adopt antiharassment and bullying strategies and intervention procedures in order to:

- To ensure all learners, staff, and school administration treat each other with courtesy and respect.
- To avoid behavior at the campus that may create an atmosphere of hostility or intimidation.
- Prevent harassment and bullying from taking place and where necessary to act upon complaints of harassment promptly and fairly.
- Reassure and support who experience harassment or bullying.

The expectations laid out in this policy apply to all working and learning in TME: learners, teachers (full time and visiting faculty), school administration, school leadership, and custodial staff.

Harrasment:

The policy recognizes the need for all of us to be aware that harassment can happen at any time. At TME, we recognise that harassment in any form might take place and so we proactively seek to guard against it. Consequently, in TME we advocate a whole-school, proactive approach in dealing with any and all forms of harassment as soon as they become evident. This policy also sets precedents for preventing harassment from starting.

Anyone can be a victim of sexual harassment, regardless of their sex and of the sex of the harasser. TME recognises that sexual harassment may also occur between learners/employee of the same sex. Anyone, including learners and staff members' who sexually harasses another will be reprimanded in accordance with this internal policy.

TME Harassment Complaint Cell

Every learner/employee has a right to be heard and if anyone



has any concern (academic, non-academic or social), he/she must report to his/her immediate

Headmistress/Coordinator/Counsellor or Principal with the guarantee that they will be heard and their concerns shall be addressed with utmost confidentiality. Harassment Complaint Cell is set up by the school / college principal where complaints of abuse or any other forms of harassment can be lodged. Formal verbal or written complaint could be lodged on

this Harassment complaint cell, as a first and preliminary step. Resolution through counselling can take place at this first step. The primary purpose of specialized office or cell is to facilitate the policy implementation in letter and spirit.

Any complaint against the school management, the learner can directly email to student confidentiality portal.




TME believes in integrating technology and advancing education. As a result, a biometric attendance system has been installed in all campuses nationwide for students and staff.
